Secretary of State for Children, Schools and Families, Ed Balls MP, this week visited Ealing with his colleague Schools Minister Jim Knight MP to re-announce a Government initiative. It gave me the chance to lobby them about the pressure on primary school places across the Borough, particularly in Ealing, Greenford and Perivale. I'm not sure we'll get anywhere with them but they know loud and clear that Ealing needs to expand its schools by the equivalent of 6 new 2 form entry primary schools in the next couple of years.
