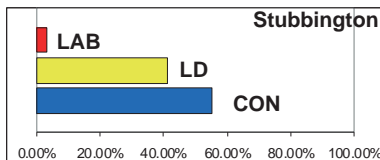

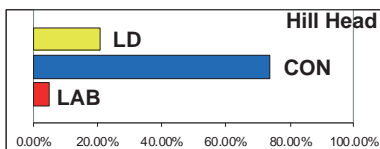

Flying at Daedalus Airfield - Latest

Following extensive negotiations between the Hampshire Constabulary, which runs the former HMS Daedalus airfield on behalf of the Coastguard (MCA), and the Lee Flying Association, which represents other users of the airstrip, a solution has been agreed that satisfies the safety concerns of the police and MCA whilst

allowing general aviation to continue at the airfield.

It has now been agreed that a new air-to-ground radio system will be paid for by the Portsmouth Naval Gliding Club and other users at no cost to the police and MCA. An administration fee will also be introduced by the police to cover any costs associated with continued general aviation.
