NEW SCHOOL CROSSING

Kay worked with local residents to improve the safety of our children by successfully petitioning Hampshire County Council for a pedestrian crossing outside Crofton and Baycroft Schools. We are delighted that this work is now complete.



SUCCESSFUL YOUTH FACILITY

Kay Mandry is a founding Trustee and Assistant Treasurer of the Crofton Youth Project which provides a youth facility for children in Stubbington and Hill Head. This project has been supported by local businesses, churches and the police. It is managed and run by volunteers.

Kay is currently working on a Council review of sheltered housing with a view to improving services and the accommodation for the tenants.



SHE ALSO CARES ABOUT THE COMMUNITY



As Chairman of the Public Protection Panel and the Crofton Community Action Team she has been working with the police and other agencies to reduce local crime and anti-social behaviour.

Joint action has achieved a 17% reduction in the past year.



She presented the case to Fareham Borough Council resulting in the purchase of Tipsy Copse which was in danger of becoming a dumping ground and informal motor cycle course.

Following a complaint from local residents regarding the poor condition of the footpath from Mayfield Close to Dale Road she has secured its resurfacing and signing by Hampshire County Council.

Methods of Voting

Voters may now cast their votes in a number of different ways

POSTAL VOTING is available to electors without the need for a reason to be given. If you have already applied for a permanent postal vote there is no need to reapply.

Applications for postal votes must be made by 5pm on the 16th April and postal votes returned by 5pm on the 1st of May.

If you think you may miss the 1st May deadline you make take your postal vote to the polling station.

Postal votes are expected to be issued on **Friday 18 April**

PROXY VOTING is available for physical incapacity or blindness; for occupation, service, employment, or attendance on a course; or to persons registered as a service voter, an overseas elector, a mental patient or remand prisoner.

New applications must be submitted by:

5pm on 23 April 2006

New proxy vote applications may be made in the circumstances of unforeseen medical emergency (which must be attested by a medical practitioner) up to the day of the poll.

You can still be really old fashioned and visit the polling station on election day
