Sue Bell says if elected I will:

- WORK** with Fareham Borough Council, the Community Centre Association and residents of Portchester to ensure that we have a new purpose built Community Centre to serve the residents of Portchester. Being a Trustee of the Portchester Parish Hall gives me a good background to achieve this as I served on the Trustee Board which strove to give Portchester residents a hall to be proud of and which is almost full to capacity.
- WORK** to respond to all enquiries or concerns within 48 hours and to keep residents informed of local issues through the *In Touch* newsletter all year round, not just at election time.
- WORK** to ensure that the Downend 'pong' operator, Veolia, will not be renewing its licence after planning consent ends in June 2011 and will start winding down operations from December 2010.
- WORK** to maintain open land which forms the strategic gaps between Fareham and Portchester. Despite mounting Government pressure for considerable extra housing in Hampshire these important open gaps should be preserved at all cost. We must preserve the important gaps at Cranleigh Road and Winnham Farm.
- WORK** with our Portchester Safer Neighbourhood Police Team as a useful liaison between residents and Police in the Portchester area. Portchester now has the largest uniformed police and PCSO presence that it has ever had, which has allowed the key issues of anti-social behaviour and juvenile nuisance to be targeted resulting in a considerable drop in the number of reported incidents.
- WORK** with Fareham Borough Council to see that faulty street lights, poor footpaths and bridlepaths, uneven pavements etc are remedied.
- WORK** with residents through the Community Action Team (CAT) forum. I believe it is important to bring residents together to discuss their concerns and ways forward to improve their quality of life.
- WORK** to ensure play areas are upgraded and suit our growing children's needs.
