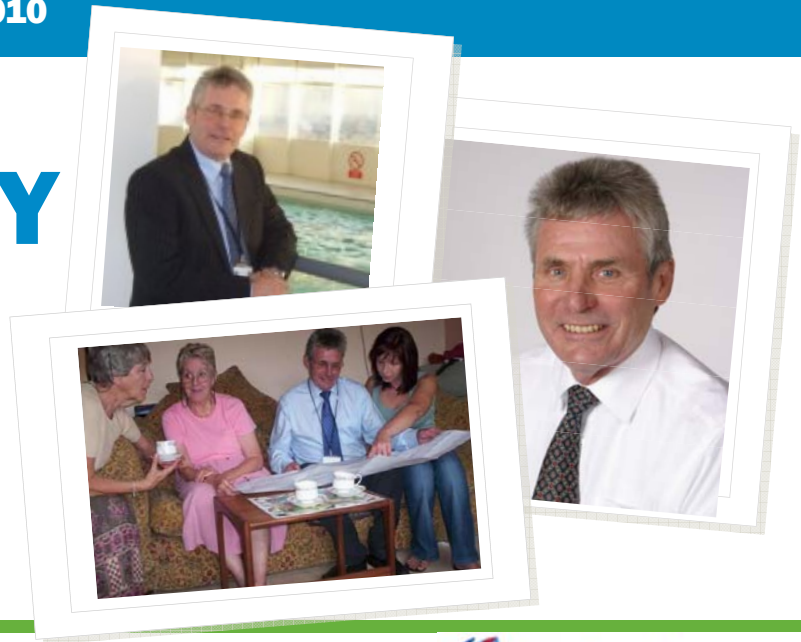

During the 40 years whilst I was a newsagent in Shoebury I was always an active member of the community, a member of the Residents Association, Traders Association and one of the founder members of the Shoebury Fair.

I always found it frustrating in trying to get the council to listen and spend money in Shoebury. I spent 17 years as a governor of Hinguar School trying to get the school remodelled.

Fortunately for me after selling my business David Ascroft the former Conservative councillor decided to retire and move to Spain, I was then asked to stand as the Conservative candidate in May 2006. Thanks to the residents support I was elected as the councillor for Shoebury.
