



Work Starts on East Beach Car Park Improvements

Despite all the misinformation put about by the Ex Labour Candidate Ann Chalk stating that the majority of residents were opposed to the new car park, I am pleased to say that work has started on the East Beach car park improvements. The new 175 space car park area will be open by the end of September. Kite surfers parking will be restricted to an area at the north end of the existing East Beach car park. By restricting the parking to two areas enables us to turn the other 12 acres into a car free safe parkland area.



The Shoebury Residents Association, the High Street Residents, the East Beach Mobile Homes Owners and the police were all in favour of the plan. After listening to residents the new cycle pathway from Blackgate Road to Rampart Terrace will now go along the existing roadway. Improvements are being made to the existing pathway that forms a direct link between the High Street and East Beach.
